The Academy Logo

The Leadership Academy logo is unique in its design and was created especially for District 5110. The logo is a combination of various sized wheels. The first wheel in the logo is the Rotary wheel which represents Rotary and its leaders. 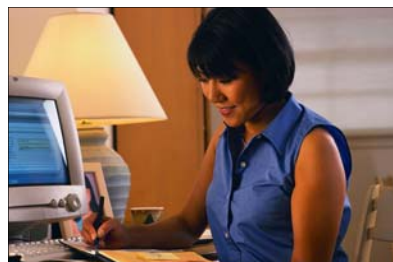

What is expected of students?

- All nominees must successfully complete an admissions survey and the Communications Course before final admission to the Academy program.
- Six core courses of study (Sept-March)
- 8 month program
- 7 assignments and 7 final exams
- All course work is available only online and all assignments must be submitted electronically. All final exams are taken online using the Hosted Test testing service.
- Mandatory Meetings
 - TRF Seminar (Oct.)
 - MG Committee Meeting (Mar)
 - District Assembly (April)
 - Final Seminar & Graduation (May)
- Timely submission of all course work. Each course must be completed within its 30-day time frame. Each final exam must be passed before proceeding to the next course. Students falling 30+ days behind may be dropped from the program with the option of completing the program the following year.



How does someone enroll?

- Past Presidents, Presidents-Elect, and Presidents-Nominee are eligible for admission as are others who are nominated by the DG or DGE.
- Admission is by nomination only.
- Nominations may be submitted by DG, DGE, DGN, PDG's, AG's, Academy Instructors, and Rotary clubs.
- Class is limited to 20 students. Those nominated by DG/DGE will be admitted only on a space available only.
